### The Lewis-Clark Valley

Located on the Washington-Idaho border, Clarkston offers the benefits of a small-town living coupled with access to world-class outdoor recreation. The town of Clarkston is situated at the bottom of Hells Canyon and just across the Snake River from Lewiston, Idaho. Upon entering Clarkston from East Highway 12, a sign reads “The Gateway to Hells Canyon,” which is the deepest river gorge in North America. Residents and visitors enjoy fishing, and water sports, along with hunting, camping, and hiking in a mild climate that designates the area as the “Banana-Belt” of the region.

For the non-outdoor enthusiast, Clarkston’s small community of just over 7,000 residents is equidistance from fine shopping in either the Tri-Cities or Spokane, WA.
